

Conversión de fichero zip a fichero xml legible para moodle

El fichero .zip hay que convertirlo en un fichero .xml que sea legible para Moodle. Eso se hace a través de la siguiente página <https://demo.poodll.com/course/view.php?id=67>

Una vez en la página hacer clic en **Create Moodle Import File** y allí subir el fichero zip obtenido de la exportación y hacer clic en **Make Moodle Questions**. Nos pide una serie de parámetros que podemos dejar por defecto. En la misma página nos informa que los tipos de pregunta de Edmodo y de Moodle son compatible excepto las matching de Edmodo. Hace ya tiempo se creó un plugin para salvar esa incompatibilidad llamado [DDMatch](#) pero que sólo está disponible hasta la versión 3.9 de Moodle. Si no se dispone conviene dejar la opción No y dar por perdidas ese tipo de preguntas.

Edmodo matching questions are drag-and-drop. Moodle matching questions are not. Also Moodle matching question answers do not support Latex notation. If you need drag-and-drop or Latex notation support in the answer options, you should install the 3rd party question type plugin DDMatch. Then select "Replace Matching with DDMatch" here and the exported question will be DDMatch format. If you do not understand this, or do not have the ability to add new plugins to your Moodle site, then do not select this option.
